Low-cost/subsidized transportation (65+); ask about agency sponsorship. The customer generally pays 40% of the trip cost.

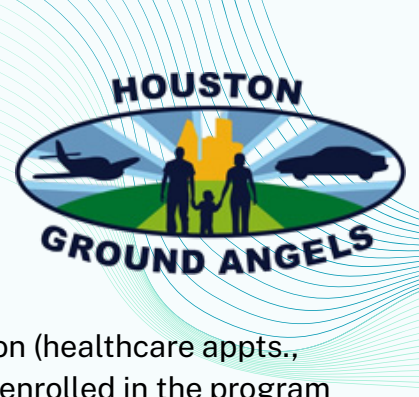
